Never share your password with anyone except trusted grown-ups

Try This: Turn your favorite phrase into a password! "I love pizza 8 days a week" becomes "ILp8daW!"




Spot the Phishing Challenge!

What is Phishing?

Phishing is when bad guys pretend to be someone you trust to trick you into giving them information. Let's learn to spot the tricks!

Warning Signs:

- Messages from people you don't know
- Asking for passwords or personal info
- Strange links or attachments
- Promises that seem too good to be true
- Spelling mistakes and weird-looking emails



Superhero Tip: When in doubt, ask a trusted adult before clicking!

Safe vs. Unsafe Secrets

✓ Safe Secrets (It's OK!)

- Surprise birthday parties
- Special gifts you're planning
- Fun surprises for friends
- Things that make you feel happy and excited

✗ Unsafe Secrets (Tell an Adult!)


- Someone asking you to keep a secret from parents
- Something that makes you feel scared or uncomfortable
- Being asked for passwords or personal information
- Anything that feels wrong or confusing

Remember: Safe secrets feel good. Unsafe secrets feel bad. Always talk to a trusted grown-up if you're unsure!


Navigate the Internet Safety Maze!

The Safe Surfing Rules

1 Think Before You Click

Always check with an adult before clicking links or downloading anything.

2 Keep Personal Info Private

Never share your full name, address, phone number, or school name online.

3 Be Kind Online

Treat others the way you want to be treated. No bullying or mean comments!

4 Tell a Trusted Adult

If something online makes you uncomfortable, tell a parent, teacher, or trusted grown-up right away.

5 Use Strong Passwords

Create unique passwords and keep them secret (except from trusted adults).




Design Your Superhero Cape!
